Contact Group (stand A230) will launch Looked After Call, designed to help local authorities accurately and securely monitor the school attendance of children in their care. Visitors to the stand can also check out Contact Group's range of communication, monitoring and reporting solutions. These include 'Text a Letter' functionality for its Call Parents cloud system, enabling schools to text letters to parents.

EPraise's (stand B368) school rewards system now includes the facility to set milestones for awarding badges. Students can be awarded a number of badges at different points levels, such as bronze at 30 points, silver at 50 and gold at 100, and receive printed customisable certificates based on the milestones.

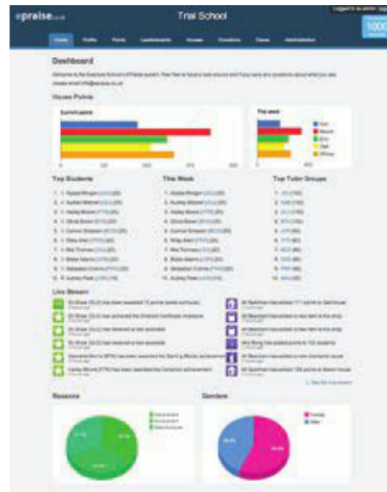
EPraise also enables students to be visibly recognised for their achievements, such as coming top of their year group, and their accolades for special activities, such as volunteering outside school.

EduMap (stand IN-10) will unveil AssessmentMap, its new pupil tracker system for primary schools. Developed using SIMS Assessment Manager, this allows schools to manage all their key performance measures for 3- to 11-year-olds from a single package. EduMap is a new partnership between education consultancy Mike Powell Associates and school management information experts School ICT Services.

Room Booking System (stand A180) will showcase the updated version of its resource booking software, which now integrates with

Capita SIMS.net for automatic synchronisation of timetable data. Schools can use the system to manage their bookings of facilities such as ICT rooms, laptop trolleys and minibuses, from any internet-connected computer.

The company will also launch its new Parents Evening System, which enables parents to make appointments, and select suitable times, with teachers online.



EPraise (stand B368)

Spanish education specialist **Grupo Edebé (stand F269)** will showcase its cloud-based teaching platform. The system encourages pupils to check their answers, to promote self-learning and self-assessment, and repeat exercises with too many mistakes. It gives teachers control of their classes, through guiding and advising students, and features an interactive digital workbook, which teachers can use to generate group tasks and multimedia resources.

Progresso Analytics is a new school information solution from **Serco Education (stand D180)**. It can be used to track behaviour and attendance, investigate trends within any cohort of learners, and explore patterns in attainment data. It then tracks the impact of interventions over time and demonstrates evidence of pupils' progress.

Serco will also launch Progresso Finance PLUS, a new module for its Progresso Management Information System, for controlling costs and improving cash flow.
